The Family Medicine Residency of Idaho's (FMRI) new academic year started July 1, 2013 with our new intern class of 16. FMRI continues to work towards excellence in graduate medical education for the state of Idaho as well as providing care to the vulnerable populations in Ada County.

The Family Medicine Residency of Idaho's (FMRI) received notice of grant award for our New Access Point application, which means FMRI has "dual status" which occurs when an organization receives a grant under section 330 (full FQHC status) as well as maintains a FQHC Look-Alike designation. FMRI received New Access Points (NAP) funding (section 330 or full FQHC status) for one of our five current sites (Meridian Clinic) in addition to two new sites in Kuna and the Meridian Schools Clinic. When the NAP

application is funded, only the site(s) listed in the NAP application (Meridian clinic, Meridian Schools Clinic, and Kuna Clinic) are included in the grant scope of project. The remaining four sites (Raymond Clinic, Fort Street Clinic, Emerald Clinic, and Garden City Clinic) will remain under the FQHC Look-Alike designation. FMRI will therefore have site(s) receiving NAP funding (section 330 or full FQHC status) and site(s) that are FQHC Look-Alikes.

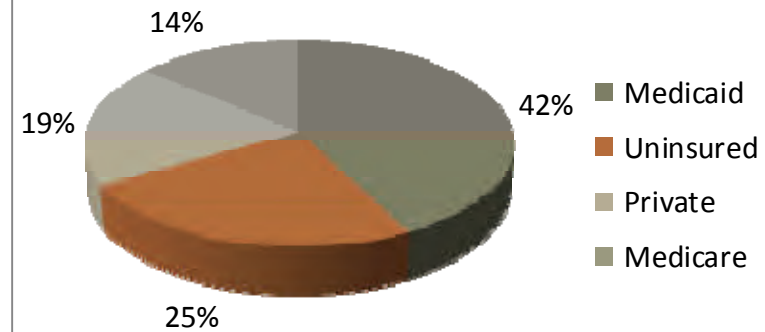

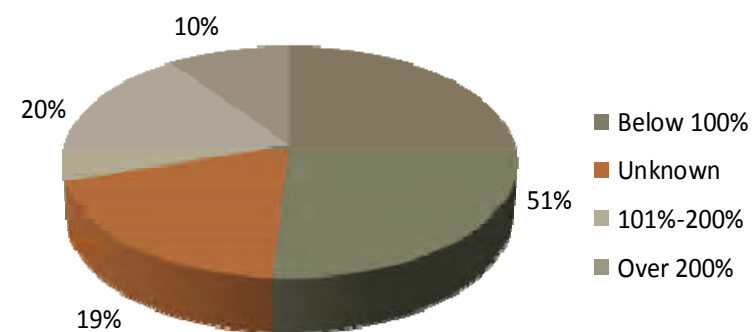
